## Schedule

We are excited to be welcoming a first-rate cohort of experts in the field of perovskite photovoltaics to present at the FuturePV Workshop.

There is much to share and learn in a full schedule of sessions, so we kindly ask all speakers to respect the following time limits:

Keynote Talks15 minutesProject Synopses8 - 10 minutesSession Talks12 - 15 minutes

At the end of each session, the speakers will have the opportunity to contribute to an interactive panel discussion lasting 15 - 20 minutes.

## Content

Keynote presentations provide a high-level overview of the main goals, learning, progress and challenges of research into perovskite PV. Light on technical details, key findings can be used effectively to deliver core messages of the workshop.

Project presentations give an overview of each project's aims, objectives, activities and results to date, outlining, where appropriate, the contributions of each partner to showcase their expertise. These presentations should be concise summaries of 8 - 10 slides.

Session presentations are an opportunity to present technical details of research and development work on the central session themes. Typically around 10 - 12 slides of content are recommended for these talks.
